

# Elementary School Profile

## School Introduction

The International School of Los Angeles is an international preschool through 12th grade school committed to academic excellence in a nurturing and intimate environment that encourages personal initiative, creativity and curiosity. All students study a common bilingual program from preschool through 9th grade after which they have a choice between two rigorous and well-balanced credentials: the French Baccalauréat and the International Baccalaureate Diploma. Our school is spread over five greater Los Angeles area campuses (our four elementary campuses mentioned below and our secondary campus in Burbank), and is over one thousand students strong. Since 1978, the School has been instilling the love of learning in all its students through small classes and low student-to-teacher ratios. With over 50 nationalities and 39 spoken languages represented on the campuses, students study and live in a diverse global community every day.

## Elementary Campuses

Each of the School's four elementary campuses has its own director, staff, community, and personality, but they all share our outstanding international education and commitment to a full immersion bilingual program.

### Los Feliz



Home to approximately 350 Preschool to 5th grade students, the campus is split over two locations. The early learning center (PS/PK) is housed in a former church annex and the main campus is located on six acres on a hill, surrounded by trees, greenery, and a community garden. Permanent structures and several modular buildings serve as classrooms, science labs, art rooms, a multipurpose room, a library, a computer lab, and offices. There is a large field and several fenced play areas.

### Pasadena



Located in the heart of Pasadena across from Pasadena City College, this campus serves 145 preschool through 5th grade students in a two-story building with a total of 11 classrooms, a separate multipurpose room, a computer lab, and a library. Canopied lunch areas shelter students at snack and lunch times, and students enjoy daily use of the basketball court and playgrounds.

### Orange County



Centrally located in the City of Orange on the grounds of Covenant Christian School, the Orange County campus currently serves 130 preschool to 8th grade students with ten classrooms, a media lab, a library, two playgrounds, an administration office, a large parking lot, a grassy field, and a gymnasium.

### West Valley



Serving 135 preschool through 5th grade students, this campus has three permanent buildings, two modular buildings, a media lab, a library, and a small pool. The elementary playground includes a shaded lunch area, a sports field, and a basketball court. Preschoolers have two classrooms and a separate playground.
