Thank you to the many parents who have reached out to us with positive feedback about our first few days of online learning. Our faculty are working tirelessly to deliver their lessons remotely and are worthy of the highest praise for what they have been able to do in such a short time. I applaud their efforts and devotion!

In light of yesterday's statewide directives, our **LA and OC campuses will remain closed to all students through Friday, April 24 inclusive.**

What will the next few weeks look like?

- Remote learning will continue for all students, preschool through 12th grade, through **Thursday, April 16** inclusive.
- **Spring break** will be preserved as scheduled, from Friday, April 17 – Friday, April 24 inclusive. No classes will take place during this time.
- The situation will be re-evaluated, and I will write to you on **Thursday, April 16** (or sooner) to apprise you of ongoing arrangements.

For parents of 9th and 12th grade students, we are currently awaiting clarification regarding the *brevet* and *baccalauréat* and the IB Diploma exams from the French Ministry of Education and the IB respectively. Please be assured that we will share any updates with you as soon as we have them.

Of course, I will continue to be in touch with our community regularly and will keep you apprised of any developments. In the meantime, my warmest wishes to everyone as we all adjust, together, to this 'new normal.'
