Dear LILA LA Community,

Thank you to all of our families who participated in last night's weekly Head of School briefing. As mentioned during the briefing, we are all very eager to welcome your children and our faculty back to campus. As of today, LA County remains in the Widespread (purple) category in the State Reopening Framework, meaning LILA's LA campuses **will not reopen for in-person K-12 learning before Tuesday, October 6, at the earliest.**

We continue to be committed to reopening as soon as is safe and practicable, but also understand that some of our families would prefer to keep their children home for a while longer. For that reason, LILA will offer a remote parallel learning option for Kindergarten through 12th grade, which will start once our campuses reopen for in-person K-12 instruction. As we look forward to the eventual reopening of our campuses, we would like to get a sense of how many families in our community feel comfortable for their children to return in person and how many would prefer the remote parallel learning option.
