Dear LILA LA Community,

Thank you to the many families who joined us for our annual State of the School meeting yesterday evening. I appreciated the opportunity to share some of the more uplifting highlights in the life of our school.

As of today, LA County remains in the Widespread (purple) tier of the State's reopening framework. However, as state and county safer at home rules are lifted, LA campuses will consider how they can welcome a limited number of students in 3rd – 12th grade under the specialized services provision. This means that **from Monday, February 1**, the following arrangements will apply for our LA-area campuses:

- By campus, preschool – 2nd grade classes will continue in person.
- In-person learning will be available for a limited number of 3rd – 12th grade students under the specialized services provision. Classes will continue in remote e-Learning mode for all other 3rd – 12th grade students. Your campus director will keep you apprised of site-specific details.

Please note that our next Head of School briefing is planned for Tuesday, February 9. Details will follow in next Wednesday's update email.
