Dear LILA LA Community,

The LA County COVID-19 case rate has maintained its favorable trend, steadily decreasing over the last several weeks. However, the County remains very much in the Widespread (purple) tier of the State's reopening framework. Therefore, this is what the next several weeks will look like for our LA-area campuses:

- By campus, **preschool – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade** classes will continue in person.
- We are hopeful that the positive trend in case rate will continue and that LA County will soon reach the required rate of 25 cases/100,000 that would enable us to reopen for 3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Until then, all **3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade** classes will continue in remote e-Learning mode.
- All **7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade** classes will continue in remote e-Learning mode for the foreseeable future.
- Under the specialized services provision, in-person learning will continue to be available only for a limited number of **3<sup>rd</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade** students, as determined by campus.
