Dear LILA LA Community,

The LA County COVID-19 case rate has maintained its steady decrease once again this week, successfully falling below the threshold that enables us to welcome our 3rd – 6th grade students in person after the February break.

Based on LA County's continued placement in the Widespread (purple) tier of the State's reopening framework, the following arrangements will continue to apply:

- By campus, **preschool – 2nd grade** classes will continue in person.
- By campus, **3rd – 6th grade** classes will begin in-person learning on Tuesday, March 2. We will continue to offer remote parallel learning for students who do not return to campus at this time.
- The positive trend in case rate redoubles our hopefulness that the County will soon reach the required rate of 7 cases/100,000 that would enable us to reopen for 7th – 12th grades. Until then:
 - All **7th – 12th grade** classes will continue in remote e-Learning mode.
 - Under the specialized services provision, in-person learning will continue to be available only for a limited number of **7th – 12th grade** students.

With our Kindergarten – 2nd grade classes operating steadily, today's Wednesday Update will mark the end of my weekly messages for K – 2.
