Important Update: Back-to-School Covid Protocols

Dear LILA community,

With the return from Summer vacation, we ask all parents to please take precautionary steps against the spread of COVID-19 and other illnesses. **If your child(ren) has recently tested positive for Covid-19, they will need to isolate for a minimum of 5 days. It is strongly recommended that they retest with an antigen test on or after Day 5**, (i.e. 5 days after the day they took their test, or from the day their symptoms started, whichever was earlier). If they test negative, they can return to school the next day.

If not tested, they may end isolation after Day 5 (i.e., between Day 6-10) only if:

- They have not had a fever for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medicine AND
- They don't have any other symptoms or their symptoms are mild and improving.

Upon return regardless of testing, a highly protective mask must be worn for 10 days since the first symptoms or positive test result.

Please notify the school if your child(ren) experiences any symptoms or has been in [close contact](#) with a Covid-19 infected person in the past 10 days and follow the close contact guidelines.
