ABOUT

The International School of Los Angeles (LILA) is an international preschool through 12th grade school committed to excellence in a nurturing and intimate environment that encourages personal initiative, creativity, and curiosity. All students study a common bilingual program from preschool through 8th grade after which they will select a pathway to one of two internationally-recognized rigorous curricula: the French Baccaauréat (FB) or the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (IB). The School welcomes approximately 1,060 students over four campuses. 26% of students receive financial aid from the school, including those with support from the French government.

Since 1978, the School has been instilling the love of learning in all its students. With over 51 nationalities and 36 spoken languages represented on the campuses, students study and live in a diverse global community every day. Our goal is to develop confident, caring, and open-minded critical thinkers who will thrive in a diverse, competitive world. We are accredited by Western Association of Schools and Colleges, the French Ministry of Education, and California Association of Independent Schools. We are an IB World School.

CURRICULUM

9th graders may choose to complete the Diplôme National du Brevet or begin the International track, a LILA-prepared integrated curriculum to prepare for the International Baccalaureate program. 10th graders will elect to begin the French Baccalauréat or continue in the International track.

Both upper-division programs include a bilingual variant: the Baccalauréat Français International (BFI) with five additional hours of English instruction, taught at Honors level; and the Bilingual Diploma (IB), with students taking two languages at the language and literature level.

The majority of students complete the entire French Baccalauréat or the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program, however, a few students elect to take a limited selection of courses at Certificate level. All students complete the UC a-g requirements. All upper level courses in 11th and 12th grades are listed below. Courses are offered over a cumulative two-years, unless otherwise noted.

***IB Students may take two languages at A level for the Bilingual Diploma. This is not limited to French, as we have students who speak other native languages.

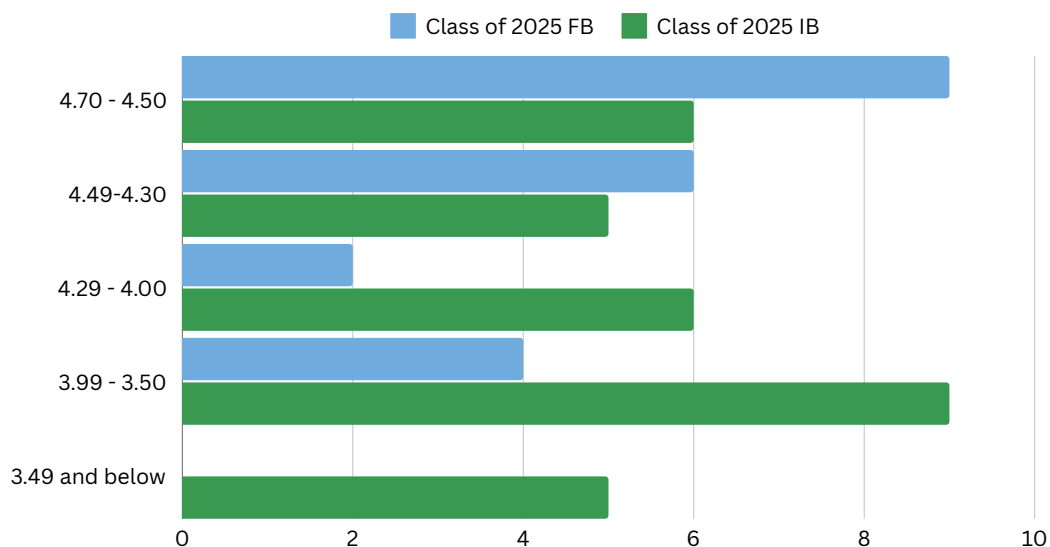
GRADE SCALE AND POLICIES

Due to separate curricula and a small class size, we do not rank students. Our GPA is calculated by converting the FB (1-20) and IB (1-7) scales to A-F.

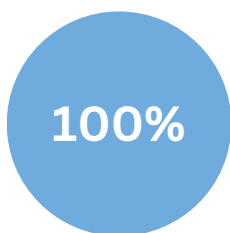
GPA points are assigned 0-4.3. Honors courses in the French Baccalauréat and Higher Level courses in the International Baccalaureate are weighted for an additional point. This is limited to 3 courses per year in 11th and 12th grade.

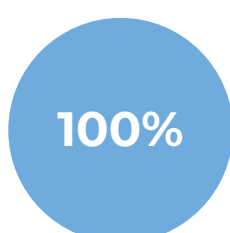
2025 GPA DISTRIBUTION



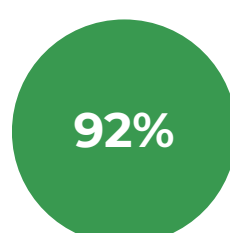
CLASS OF 2024 EXAM RESULTS



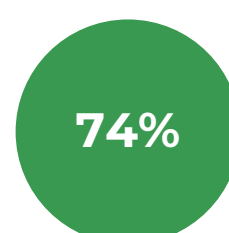
Achieved French Baccalauréat



Achieved BFI (50% of FB cohort)



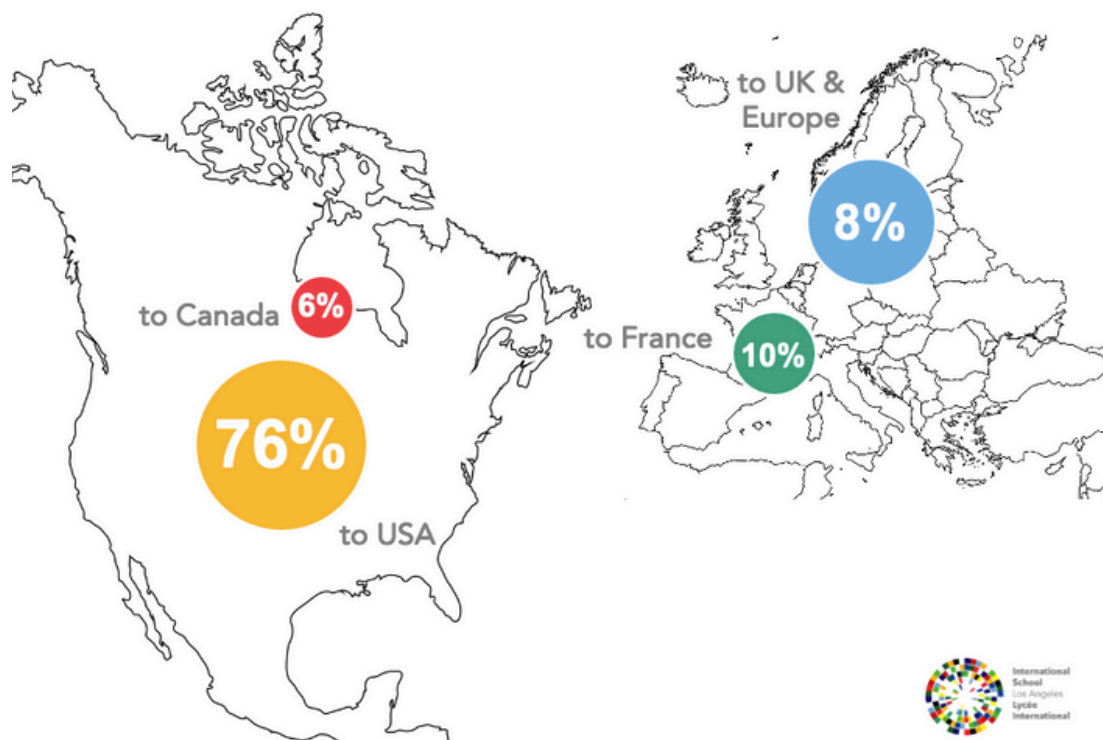
Achieved International Baccalaureate Diploma
