Athletics -LILA competes in the Liberty League within the CIF Southern Section, offering 10 high school varsity sports with an average of 14 student-athletes per team. Notably, the cross country program has achieved historic success, with the girls' team securing back-to-back league championships and the boys' team producing the school's first-ever state qualifier.

COMMUNITY IN CONTEXT

- Pre-K to 12th grade
- ~ 1,000 students
- 51 nationalities, 36 languages spoken (majority are U.S. citizens/green card holders)
- 26% receive financial aid, including institutional aid and French government support.
- As an international school, there is a slight transient culture, with students studying abroad or joining us within the high school years. Our transcript only includes coursework taken at LILA.

CURRICULUM

As 9th graders the Class of 2027 chose to either complete the Diplôme National du Brevet, the French qualifying exam, or begin the International track, a LILA-prepared integrated curriculum to prepare for the International Baccalaureate program. 10th graders could elect to begin the French Baccalauréat or continue in the International track. In 2025, LILA introduced the IB Middle Years Programme, folding in the International curriculum, accessible as early as 6th grade to students.

Both upper-division programs include a bilingual variant: the Baccalauréat Français International (BFI) with **six additional hours of English instruction**, taught at Honors level; and the Bilingual Diploma (IB), with students taking **two languages at academic literature level**.

Graduation Requirements

All students are required to fulfill California's minimum high school requirements *and* the UC A-G requirements for graduation, per our CAIS accreditation. **They will receive a U.S. High School Diploma, and, in addition, aim for the French Baccalauréat or the International Baccalaureate Diploma.** Students may also complete IB coursework at certificate level toward the U.S. Diploma. All upper level courses in 11th and 12th grades are listed below. Courses are offered over a cumulative two years, unless otherwise noted, ending with their official exams in May of 12th grade.

³FB Math is an integrated pathway, with 11th grade Math covering primarily Precalculus, and 12th grade Math covering Calculus, advanced Statistics/Probability, and 3D Analytic Geometry.

GRADE SCALE AND POLICIES

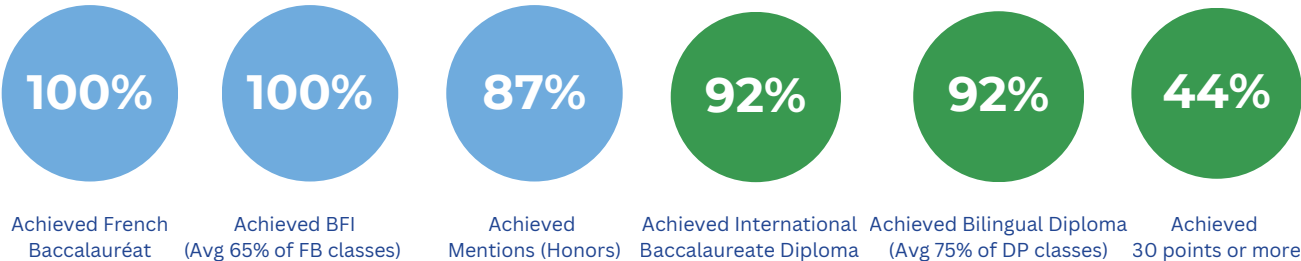

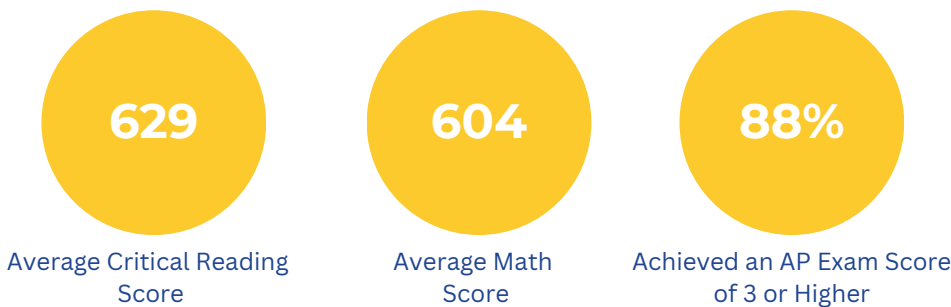
HISTORICAL EXAM RESULTS

Average results from the Classes of 2024-2026.

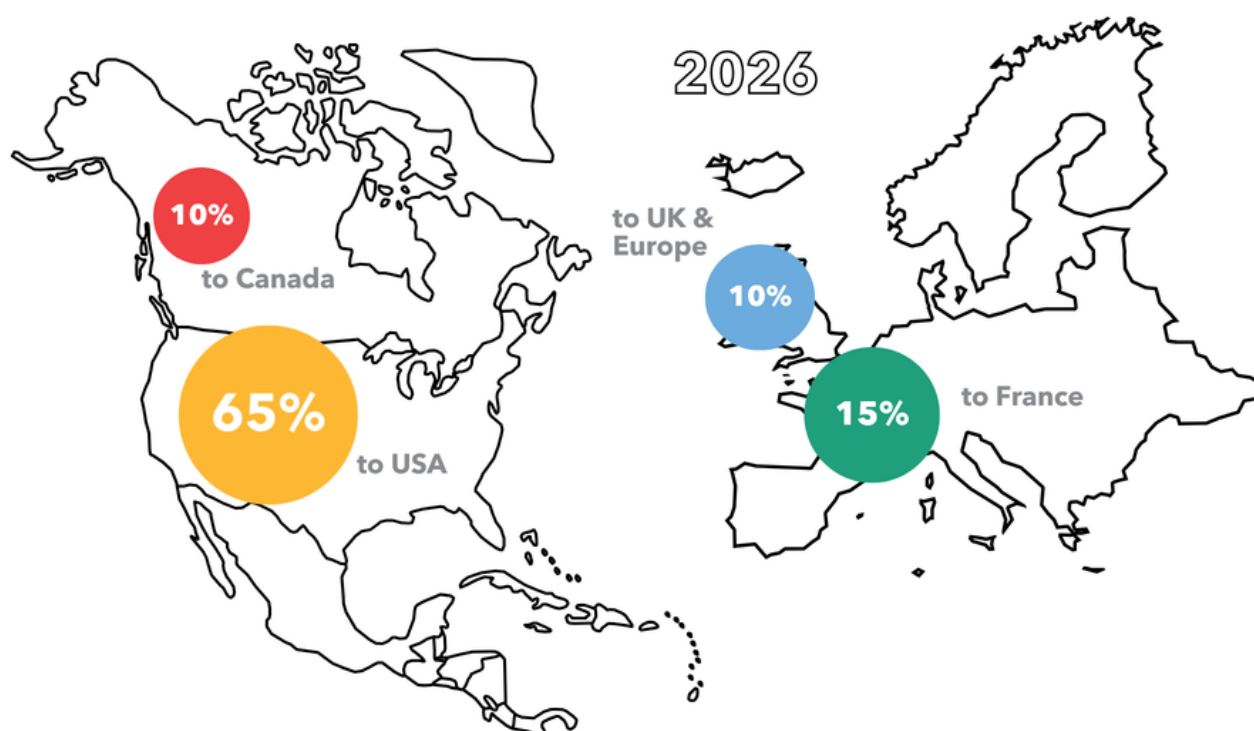


U.S. STANDARDIZED TESTING

LILA students have started to engage more with standardized testing, however only 35 students of the senior class have taken the SAT at least one time before October 2026. The ACT has not picked up much traction with only 3-5 students attempting the exam. Though we only offer two AP courses (French Language and English Literature), a handful of students elect to self-study for exams reflecting their personal interests.
